ORDINANCE 2010-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING REGULATIONS FOR REFUSE CONTAINERS AND DUMPSTERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, County of Union, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Township of Cranford adopts amendments to regulations for refuse containers and dumpsters at Chapter 112, Garbage, Rubbish and Refuse, as follows:

1. Article V, Refuse Containers and Dumpsters

§112-30. Prohibited Conduct:

Any person who controls, whether owned, leased, or operated, a refuse container or dumpster must ensure that such container or dumpster is covered at all times and shall prevent refuse from spilling out or overflowing.

Any person who owns, leases or otherwise uses a refuse container or dumpster must ensure that such container or dumpster does not leak or otherwise discharge liquids, semi-liquids or solids to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Township of Cranford.

Any person who controls, whether owned, leased or operated, a refuse container or dumpster that is placed in any public right of way shall have light reflectors placed thereon which are visible after dark to passing motorists and others using the public right of way. Any person who controls, whether owned, leased or operated, a container or dumpster must ensure that planks are placed under the wheels of any container or dumpster placed in any street or public right of way.

2. No Other Amendment:

All other provisions of Chapter 112, Article V, shall remain unchanged.

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law
