Bite Back! Protect yourself from mosquitoes





Aside from an annoying itchy bump, a mosquito bite can spread diseases, such as West Nile, Zika, yellow fever and malaria.


Help prevent mosquito bites by doing the following:

- If possible, limit time outdoors between dusk and dawn when mosquitoes are most active.
- Weather permitting, wear long-sleeved and lightcolored clothing.
- Use insect repellent and follow the label instructions.



Control mosquitoes indoors and outdoors by:

- Using air conditioning.
- Using window and door screens.
- Washing produce thoroughly.
- Since mosquitoes breed in water, eliminating all standing water in gutters, unused pools, wheelbarrows, buckets, containers, outside toys, etc.
