Duties include but are not limited to chipping, landscaping, leaf/brush collection, shoveling, plowing, storm sewer maintenance, road work, paving, building & grounds maintenance, cleaning, and other duties related to public works projects as assigned and as needed. Must be able to lift 90lbs. High School diploma or equivalent required. Candidate must be customer service oriented and possess the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, officials, and the general public. Must possess the ability to follow directions and complete assigned tasks within established deadlines. Valid New Jersey Driver's License in good standing is required. Candidates in possession of CDL B in good standing, or the ability to obtain within 6 months, preferred. The ability to operate trucks with manual transmissions a plus.
