AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, CHAPTER 410 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, in the County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 410, Part 2 Municipal Parking Lots, Section 410-81, is hereby amended by substituting the following for Section E:

E. Parking shall be allowed by meter or other parking device or by permit in the municipal parking lots designated below:

SECTION 2. Chapter 410, Part 2 Municipal Parking Lots, is hereby amended to add a new ARTICLE XXV as follows:

# ARTICLE XXV Municipal Parking Lot No. 19

#### § 410-125. Designation of premises.

There is hereby established on the premises hereinafter described a permit parking area for the parking of motor vehicles, owned by Cranford residents only, to be designated as "Parking Lot No. 19."

#### § 410-126. Description of premises.

Municipal Parking Lot No. 19 shall be located on the lot designated as Block 195, Lot 2, on the official Cranford Tax Map, fronting on North Avenue East and located between 24 North Avenue East and 32 North Avenue East.

#### § 410-127. Regulations.

- A. This lot shall be in operation between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- B. During the hours and days set forth in Subsection B of this section, it shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or operated by such person to be parked in any twelve-hour parking space without the required permit affixed to said motor vehicle.
- C. No person shall park or permit any vehicle to remain parked in this lot between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- D. The Chief of Police may designate certain parking spaces for handicapped persons. Such spaces shall be properly posted and shall be available only to vehicles with proper special identification as belonging to handicapped persons. Such designation as handicapped person spaces shall conform in all ways to the appropriate state statute and regulations.

**SECTION 3. Chapter 410, Part 3 Municipal Parking Garages,** is hereby amended to renumber the Articles XXVI and XXVI as Articles XXVI & XXVII respectively.

**SECTION 4. Chapter 410, Part 3 Municipal Parking Garages,** is hereby amended to renumber the § 410-125 through § 410-129 to § 410-128 through § 410-132, respectively.

**SECTION 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication according to law.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2018-12

# AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE SUNNY ACRES AS A CRANFORD HISTORIC DISTRICT

WHEREAS the Cranford Historic Preservation Board ("HPAB") has been charged by the Township of Cranford (the "Township") to identify historic sites, districts and landmarks within the Township and to recommend the designation as local historic sites; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2018, HPAB presented a nomination report with regard to Sunny Acres, a district bordered by Raritan Road, Oraton Drive, and the Rahway River; and including Mohawk and Algonquin Drives, Oneida, Mohican, and Iroquois Places, and Iroquois, Cherokee, and Raritan Roads, a copy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, after notice to the public and personal notice to the owners of properties in the district, HPAB held a public hearing on May 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing on May 30, 2018, HPAB unanimously recommended that the Township Committee designate Sunny Acres as a local historic district; and

**WHEREAS**, HPAB tendered its nomination report to the Cranford Township Committee under cover of a letter dated June 2, 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, County of Union, State of New Jersey, that:

#### Section 1.

- (1) For the reasons set forth in HPAB's nomination report dated June 2, 2018, the district defined therein and known as Sunny Acres, is hereby designated a Local Historic District.
- (2) The Planning Board list and map the aforementioned District in the Master Plan.
- (3) The designation of this district shall be noted on all records maintained by the Township Tax Assessor and the Township Clerk.
- (4) Notice of this designation shall be made public by publication in the official newspaper of the Township and by distribution to all municipal agencies reviewing development applications and permits.
- (5) A letter of designation shall be sent to the owners of record of the properties in the district.

**Section 2.** SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of the Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall been deemed valid and effective.

**Section 3.** REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES. Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13**

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, CHAPTER 255 LAND DEVELOPMENT, ARTICLE V ZONING, SECTION 255-35D "YARD REGULATIONS"

**WHEREAS**, Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, New Jersey adopted a comprehensive Land Development Ordinance ("LDO") for the Township of Cranford; and

**WHEREAS**, §255-35D of the Code of the Township of Cranford provides for exceptions to nonconforming front porches and uncovered steps on residential properties in residential zones.

**WHEREAS**, it is desired to include all currently pre-existing, legal nonconforming uncovered front steps in required front yard areas on residential properties as permitted to be reconstructed without change to dimensions or footing locations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 255, Article V Zoning, Section 255-35D.3 is hereby amended as follows:

§255-35D(3) Yard Regulations

(3) Uncovered steps only may project up to five feet into a required front or rear yard. If the existing front yard setback is nonconforming, uncovered steps may be reconstructed in their existing locations and footprints, but not increased further in size or encroach further into the required front yard area.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3.** If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-14**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, CHAPTER 255 LAND DEVELOPMENT, ARTICLE IV DESIGN STANDARDS, SPECIFIC, SECTION 255-26G "CIRCULATION, DRIVEWAYS, PARKING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING REQUIREMENTS"

**WHEREAS,** Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, New Jersey a comprehensive Land Development Ordinance ("LDO") for the Township of Cranford; and

**WHEREAS**, §255-26G Circulation, Driveways, Parking and Loading and Unloading Requirements of the Code of the Township of Cranford provides design standards for the construction of driveways for one- and two- family residences in the township; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desired to introduce a front yard parking ordinance prohibiting parking directly in front of principal structures on one- and two- family properties.

**WHEREAS**, it is desired to include all currently pre-existing, legal nonconforming driveways in required side yard areas on residential properties as permitted to be reconstructed without change to dimensions or footing locations.

**WHEREAS**, it is also desired to remove the requirement for granite block curbing for driveways for one- and two- family residences.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 255, Article IV Development Requirements and Standards, Section 255-26G(3)a is hereby amended as follows:

§255-26G(3)a Minimum setbacks and area requirements for parking areas.

(a) Location of parking. No required off-street parking area shall be located in a minimum required setback as set forth in the minimum setbacks for parking areas found below except for driveways used solely for access to parking areas. Driveways for one and two- family residences are exempt from providing a driveway setback, except new construction driveways in locations where a driveway previously did not exist. All currently existing driveways as of the date of the passing of this chapter are considered pre-existing, nonconformities that are permitted to be repaved, however the repaving cannot result in a nonconforming driveway setback becoming less conforming.

§255-26G(3)a.4 delete

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 255, Article IV Development Requirements and Standards, Section §255-26G(8) is hereby amended as follows:

§255-26G(8) (g)

(g) Parking areas, loading areas and driveways shall be curbed with granite block. One- and two-family residences are exempt from this requirement.

§255-26G(8) (h)

(h) Driveways and parking areas for one- and two-family residences shall be paved from the driveway apron to the front building setback line, but not directly in front of the principal structure, except circular driveways constructed to the standards herein. The remainder shall be improved either with paving or with washed gravel or stone not

exceeding 3/4 inch. The maximum permitted width of such driveways shall be 10 feet or 1/3 the lot width, whichever is greater, but in no case shall the width of any driveway exceed 26 feet. Circular driveways shall not exceed 15 feet in width. Parking shall only be permitted on a driveway or an improved parking area.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING \$9,700,000 OF NOTES CONSISTING OF \$8,366,000 GENERAL BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES AND \$1,334,000 SWIM POOL UTILITY BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES, BOTH ISSUES DATED JUNE 29, 2018 AND PAYABLE JUNE 28, 2019, AS "QUALIFIED TAXEXEMPT OBLIGATIONS" PURSUANT TO SECTION 265(b)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranford, in the County of Union, New Jersey (the "Township") intends to issue \$9,700,000 of Notes consisting of \$8,366,000 General Bond Anticipation Notes and \$1,334,000 Swim Pool Utility Bond Anticipation Notes, both issues dated June 29, 2018 and payable June 28, 2019 (collectively, the "Notes"); and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to designate the Notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code");

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, in the County of Union, New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Notes are hereby designated as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said Notes are not "private activity bonds" as defined in the Code and (2) the Township and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2018.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. It is further determined and stated that the Township has, as of the date hereof, issued the following tax-exempt obligations (other than the Notes) during the calendar year 2018, viz:

<u>SECTION 4</u>. The Township will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of tax-exempt obligations pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code; however, said Township does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. The issuing officers of the Township be and they hereby are authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Notes and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2018 dated as of the date of delivery of the Notes.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
