ORDINANCE NO. 2022-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR AN AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT CONSISTING OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES LOCATED AT BLOCK 193, LOTS 6.01, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-131 adopted on February 11, 2020, the Cranford Township Committee directed the Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 to determine whether the properties designated on the Township tax map as Block 193, Lots 6.01, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14 (the "Properties") qualifies as a condemnation area in need of redevelopment according to the criteria set forth in Section 5 of the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board directed Maser Consulting P.A. (now Collier's Engineering and Design) to undertake an investigation of the Properties and prepare a preliminary investigation report as required by the statute, and Maser Consulting P.A. (Maser) prepared a Preliminary Investigation Report ("Preliminary Investigation"); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board provided the required legal notices and conducted a public meeting in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 on August 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, during the aforesaid hearings, the Planning Board reviewed the Preliminary Investigation Report prepared by Maser dated July 2020, and heard testimony from Nick Dickerson, PP, a planning expert employed by Maser, and author of said report; and

WHEREAS, upon review and consideration of the aforementioned report, the exhibits entered into evidence, and the testimony presented during the hearings, the Planning Board determined that the Properties satisfy the criteria for designation as a Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment pursuant to the aforementioned statute; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2020, the Planning Board voted to recommend to the Township Committee that the Properties be designated a Condemnation Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2020, the Planning Board adopted Resolution No. 2020-011 memorializing its August 19, 2020 vote accepting and adopting the conclusions contained in the Study and recommending designation of the Properties as a Condemnation Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-298, ("Redevelopment Resolution"), dated September 8, 2020, the Township Committee designated the Property as a Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment, as provided in N.J.S.A.40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Resolution was transmitted to the State of New Jersey Commissioner of the Department of Community Affairs ("DCA") via overnight delivery, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 12A-6; and

WHEREAS, a redevelopment project located in an Area in Need of Redevelopment must be undertaken in accordance with a Redevelopment Plan, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee authorized Topology NJ, LLC to prepare a Redevelopment Plan for the Property in accordance with the requirements of the Redevelopment Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, County of Union and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Redevelopment Plan, a copy of which is annexed hereto and made part of this Ordinance, is adopted in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7 of the Redevelopment Law.

Section 2. This Ordinance constitutes an amendment to the Zoning Map for the Township of Cranford included in the Land Development Ordinance of the Township of Cranford, New Jersey.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to such section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5. A copy of this Ordinance and the Redevelopment Plan shall be available for public inspection at the office of the Township Clerk during regular business hours.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with all applicable laws.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO REPEAL CHAPTER 232 IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranford, in the County of Union, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), adopted Ordinance No. 2019-10 on August 13, 2019 entitled Single-Use Plastics, to preserve public health, safety and welfare by reducing the environmental impact of single-use plastics; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2019-10 was subsequently codified in the Municipal Code of the Township of Cranford at Chapter 232, Article V, Sections 30 to 37; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has enacted P.L.2020, c.117 (effective date of November 4, 2020—signed into law), which explicitly supersedes and preempts any municipal or county rule, regulation code, or ordinance concerning the regulation or prohibition of single-use plastic carryout bags or single use paper carryout bags; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to repeal Ordinance No. 2019-10 to avoid consumer and business confusion; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, in the County of Union, State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2019-10, codified as Chapter 232, Article V, Sections 30 to 37, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

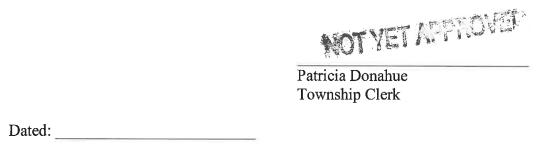

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TM FOODS FOR THE CONCESSION RIGHTS AT THE CENTENNIAL AVENUE OUTDOOR POOL FOR THE 2022 SUMMER SEASON

WHEREAS, in 2021 the Centennial Avenue Outdoor Pool was closed because of the pandemic, and there exists a need in 2022 for a vendor to operate the concession stand at the Centennial Avenue Pool for the summer season; and

WHEREAS, several food services companies have made offers for payment to the Township for the right to operate the concession stand at the Centennial Avenue Outdoor Pool location through a non-fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Moore, owner of TM Foods, with a business address of 12 Harold Johnson Place in Cranford, New Jersey 07016, has made an offer to pay \$9,000 to the Township for the summer 2022 concession rights; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent has determined and certified in writing that the value of the contract will not exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Moore has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification, which certifies that neither he nor TM Foods have made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Cranford in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Thomas Moore and TM Foods from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has deemed that TM Foods has the expertise and qualifications to render the needed services at the Centennial Avenue Outdoor Pool for the 2022 summer season; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford authorizes a contract with TM Foods in the amount of \$9,000 to be paid by TM Foods to the Township of Cranford in exchange for food concession rights at the Centennial Avenue Outdoor Pool and limited to the 2022 summer season; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Committee authorizes the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with TM Foods, 12 Harrold Johnson Place, Cranford, New Jersey, 07016 as described herein and that the Township Administrator be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to notify TM Foods of the Township Committee's decision.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-229

WHEREAS, there were 558 motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey in 2019; and

WHEREAS, a large percentage of the motor vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes were not wearing a seat belt; and

WHEREAS, use of a seat belt remains the most effective way to avoid death or serious injury in a motor vehicle crash; and

WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that 14,955 lives were saved by safety belt usage nationally in 2017. From 2013 to 2017, seat belts saved nearly 69,000 lives; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the nationwide *Click It or Ticket* seat belt mobilization from May 23rd to June 6, 2022 in an effort to raise awareness and increase seat belt usage through a combination of high visibility enforcement and public education; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety has set a goal of increasing the seat belt usage rate in the State from the current level of almost ninety (90) per cent (%) to ninety-five (95) per cent (%); and

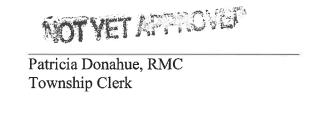
