**WHEREAS**, Sunesys LLC ("Sunesys"), is a telecommunications provider with a business address of 202 Titus Avenue, Warrington, Pennsylvania, authorized to provide service by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities and the Federal Communications Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 11, 2017, the Township of Cranford and Sunesys, as a utility and common carrier, entered into a Rights of Way Agreement authorizing Sunesys to install fiber optic cable in the Township's public right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS** Sunesys has requested approval to install fiber optic cable on five additional existing telephone, electric or cable conduit poles located on the public Rights-of Way;

**WHEREAS** the Municipality is empowered to enter into this agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48: 17-10 through N.J.S.A. 48: 17-12; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of Cranford and its citizenry for the municipality to grant consent to Sunesys to occupy said Public Rights-of-Way within the Municipality for this purpose; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranford, on this 25th day of September 2018, that Sunesys is authorized to install fiber optic cable on five additional existing telephone, electric or cable conduit poles located on the public Rights-of Way consistent with the plans submitted to the Township and on file in the Clerk's office, and subject to all of the terms of the July 11, 2017 Rights of Way Agreement.
