NEWS FROM TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETINGS

- Adopted procedures and requirements for remote meetings during the declared State of Emergency. - Adopted a Sustainable Land Use Pledge
- Reauthorized a Cost Sharing agreement with other municipalities in the Mayors Council for the Rahway River Watershed Flood Control.
- Discussed adoption of an Anti-Nepotism policy for Township hiring, including prohibiting hiring family members of elected officials. Further discussion will take place at the January 25 Workshop Meeting with a vote at the Official Meeting on January 26.
- Municipal department heads presented first draft of 2021 budgets at a special meeting held Saturday, Jan. 16.
