The roof over the porch will protect anyone approaching or standing at the front door from the weather (rain or snow). Part of the charm of Cranford comes from the many front porches on houses new and old. The owners would like the porch to greet neighbors and friends as they walk or bicycle past the house and to provide a shaded, welcoming area to sit and entertain.

The homeowners are also proposing an attic redesign with this application. The expansion in volume (not area) of the attic provides for additional contemporary living space without expanding the foot print of the house or increasing the impervious area. The maximum height of a residential structure will not be exceeded.

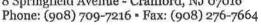

### 4. Arguments in Support of Relief

The property is not located in the Flood Overlay District. The proposed building coverage is less than the maximum allowable. The proposed impervious area is less than the maximum allowable. The proposed front porch projects only 2.89 feet into the required front yard setback. The porch is to be an attractive one story addition with a simple shed roof that will blend with the architecture of the house with open walls and well maintained landscaping to soften the edges.

The proposed attic redesign will be in compliance with the zoning ordinance as it relates to height and area. Only the volume will increase due to the addition of dormers. The new space will be used by the same number of people in a single family household.

The proposed construction will bring the new living space into compliance with current life safety building and energy codes. Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are to be installed, egress windows will be added, the existing pull down stairs are to be replaced with walk upstairs compliant with state building codes for width, riser height and tread depth. The side walls of the rear dormer are set in 6 feet from the roof rake. The side walls of the front dormer are set in 9.5 feet from the roof rake. These dormer setbacks reduce the visable impact of the new construction.

Relief can be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and will not substantially impair the intent and purpose of the zone plan and zoning ordinance. There will be little to no change to adequate light, air & open space.

There is no negative impact on the neighborhood, no noise, smoke, ash, pollution, odors, towers or prohibited uses on the property.

Approval will not substantially impair the intent and purpose of the Zone Plan, Zoning Ordinance and Master Plan.
