## 10 Tips for Parking in Downtown Cranford

- 1 Are you just making a quick stop? Then simply press "10 Minutes Free," take your receipt and go.
- 2 Is your visit going to take just a bit longer? You can add time to your space at the pay station or from your smart phone.
- 3 Street spaces have a 90 minutes time limit to ensure regular turnover for those making a quick stop.
- We encourage you to stay longer and use the parking lots for 3-hour visits and the parking garage for up to 4 hours.
- 5 There is FREE parking in downtown Cranford after 6 pm and all day Sunday
- 6 Please do not park in spaces marked "Permit Only." These are for business owners, employees and commuters.
- Parking is only 25¢ for 30 minutes but it can be expensive if you park at fire hydrants, tow away zones or other restricted areas. So go for a metered spot on the street or in the parking lots and don't forget to pay.
- 8 Don't park on North Avenue W. between N. Union and Eastman weekdays between 4:30 and 6 pm. This state highway has parking restrictions during those hours.
- 9 There is plenty of downtown parking. In fact, there are more than 800 spaces just for shoppers and visitors.
- Walk. It's good for you and it's free. Besides, you may discover new stores and restaurants on the way to your destination.

- **E** Lot 3 / North Avenue (rear of Cervantes) 3 hr visitor & permit parking

- Warner Plaza / North Avenue
  3 hr visitor parking
- G Lot 4 / Train Station South Avenue Commuter permit parking Free Saturday & Sunday; weekdays after 10:30 am
- H Lot 6 / Chestnut & High Streets
  12 hr visitor parking
