Review Official Meeting Agenda

Late Starter – MDTV Parking Lot Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2018-11

Township Attorney Ryan Cooper discussed the late starter Official Meeting agenda item, Ordinance No. 2018-11 introduction (regarding the MDTV parking lot.) A brief discussion ensued regarding the elimination of proposed regulation A, Section 2, Chapter 410-127, which required all permits to be issued to Cranford residents. Committee consensus was reached to vote on the proposed ordinance introduction during the Official Meeting as was noted on the updated Agenda document.

Late Starter - Historic Preservation Advisory Board (HPAB)

Discussion ensued regarding the proposed Mayoral appointment of Commissioner O'Connor to the Historic Preservation Advisory Board. Committee consensus was reached that this Mayoral appointment would be listed as an Agenda item at the June 26th Official Meeting.

Late Starter – Post Office Plaza

Commissioner O'Connor stated that she would like the Committee to consider an updated version of her previous evening's motion, specifically that 1) there would be a \$15,000 rider created exclusively for the Flag Pole maintenance and restoration, and 2) the remaining funds would be utilized for public space improvements. Commissioner O'Connor motioned and Deputy Mayor Dooley seconded. Commissioners O'Connor and Giblin and Deputy Mayor

Dooley were in favor of the motion. Mayor Hannen and Commissioner Maisonneuve were opposed to the motion.
